Dear Mr Hayes

I am writing to advise you of proposed changes to the structures of the Business Units within the Population Health, South Western Sydney Local Health District (SWSLHD) which has the potential to directly affect your members.

Population Health protects and promotes the health of the local people and communities. SWSLHD Population Health involves the coordinated efforts of its units and services including: the Health Promotion Service, Public Health Unit, NSW Refugee Service, BreastScreen, Healthy People and Places Unit, and the Centre for Health Equity Training, Research and Evaluation (CHETRE). Population Health embeds prevention by delivering a variety of services ranging from individual patient care to programs that reach into the communities of SWSLHD.

Following a comprehensive consultation process with the Population Health Executive, staff and stakeholders across the District, a Population Health Operational Framework was developed. The Operational Framework will build an innovative Population Health portfolio and elevate the capacity of Population Health to deliver and maintain systematic population health activity across SWSLHD, facilitating professional and proactive delivery of contemporary Population Health services. This will provide clear role delineation, reduced duplication, and increased efficiency. This Operational framework will align with the *Keeping People Healthy: SWSLHD Prevention Plan to 2028*, integrate Population Health with clinical and non-clinical services provided by LHD and enable joint action on shared key stakeholder and community priorities.

To ensure the proposed changes have the input of employees, consultation is being planned, in line with the consultative provisions of the Health Employees Conditions of Employment (State) Award and Public Hospitals (Professional and Associated Staff) Conditions of Employment (State) Award.
