I write regarding Mr Kearns concerns around information received from members regarding a review of the model of care for the Transition Aged Care Program (TACP) and the alleged removal of intake duties from HSU members' roles. I would like to take this opportunity to inform the Health Services Union (HSU) that there will be no change in the role and function of staff in TACP.


I would like to take this opportunity to remind the HSU that one of the primary aims of the Community and Allied Health restructure is to have consistency of services across the district. Currently, for the majority of our services we have different models of care across Tweed, Murwillumbah, Byron and Lismore, Casino and Ballina and Grafton and Maclean. We have completed the realignment process for Specialist Palliative Care and Integrated Prevention and Response to Violence Abuse and Neglect, with these services sitting under one manager and operating as a single service. The district is committed to realigning models of care across the district we would like to reassure that HSU that this process is not a review process.

We would also like to reassure the Health Services Union that during this process there will be no change to clinicians' role, function or location. Community and Allied Health has over sixty different service types.
