Re: Changes to the Nursing, Midwifery, Clinical Governance and innovation Directorate

I refer to our previous correspondence on 13 January 2023 and 17 February 2023 regarding the Justice Health and Forensic Mental Health Network (Justice Health NSW) realignment of its Executive and Direct reports to the Chief Executive, Ms Wendy Hoey.

Consultation with the current Executive Team and affected staff has occurred and we are now able to commence with the realignments at subsequent tiers/levels. Justice Health NSW would like to advise you of the proposed changes to the Directorate of the Nursing, Midwifery, Clinical Governance and innovation. The realignment is part of Justice Health NSW positioning itself to deliver on the new Justice Health NSW Strategic plan. It is anticipated that affected staff, where possible, will be aligned to suitable positions following due policy.
