Re: Transfer of employment from HealthShare NSW to eHealth NSW 16 May 2023

Dear Mr Hayes,

I am writing to formally notify the Health Services Union (HSU) of the proposed transfer of the System Service and Delivery (SSD) IT Team within HealthShare NSW to the Support Applications Team, Corporate Applications, Service Delivery within eHealth NSW.

The SSD IT team currently sits within the System Service Delivery Directorate within HealthShare NSW. This team provides a range of IT support services to Enable NSW and Patient Transport Services. They also provide IT support for the Task Allocation System with Patient Services and Planning (PSP) Directorate.

The transition of the SSD IT team to eHealth NSW is intended to provide ongoing stability, build capability, depth of knowledge, governance and minimise support risk across business lines and will strengthen the contract management with current suppliers.

There are currently thirteen (13) employees working within the SSD IT Team. The proposed transfer from HealthShare NSW to eHealth NSW will create thirteen (13) new permanent full time equivalent employees in Corporate Applications within eHealth NSW. The transition will result in a change of role title, role descriptions (RD) and employer. The proposed RDs have been reviewed by eHealth Workforce and it is noted that the changes will not impact the overarching role and responsibilities of the existing employees and there will be no changes to FTE, grade, or employment status. The proposed title changes are consistent with the position title convention utilised with eHealth NSW.

A virtual staff consultation meeting will be held on Wednesday 17 May 2023 at 1pm to discuss the proposed transition, and the HSU are invited. Please let Kristin Matthews, Senior HR Business Partner know if a Union Organiser will attend the meeting.
