CHANGES TO MEDICAL IMAGING POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

In accordance with Section G1 of the ACT Public Sector Health Professional Enterprise Agreement 2021-2022 where there are proposals by the ACT Public Service to introduce change within a Division, the Head of Service will consult with the affected employees and relevant unions.

As you are aware, the ACT Government committed funding to improve diagnostic capabilities at Canberra Hospital in response to population growth, increased service demand, technology developments and ageing equipment. The expansion of Medical Imaging Services includes the establishment of the Weston Creek Imaging Service at the Weston Creek Community Health Centre, as well as a dedicated space in the new Critical Services Building, now referred to as Building 5, at the Canberra Hospital in mid-2024.

I am writing to advise that minor amendments have been made to the following Position Descriptions to reflect the expansion of services in the Medical Imaging Department:

- Medical Imaging Level 2 (MI2) Radiographer (<u>Attachment A</u>)
- Medical Imaging Level 3 (MI3) Advanced Radiographer (<u>Attachment B</u>)
- Medical Imaging Level 4 (MI4) Clinical Educator (<u>Attachment C</u>)
- Medical Imaging Level 5 (MI5) Deputy Chief Radiographer (<u>Attachment D</u>)
- Medical Imaging Level 6 (MI6) Director of Allied Health (<u>Attachment E</u>)

Please note, there have been **NO** changes to the duties of these roles or to the selection criteria.
