I write to provide you with information in relation to the commencement of enabling works at Royal Prince Alfred (RPA) Hospital as part of the RPA Hospital Redevelopment and Sydney Biomedical Accelerator (SBA).

The King George V (KGV) Car Park, located directly behind the KGV Building will be closing and the space will be used to temporarily accommodate the relocation of services during the RPA Hospital Redevelopment.

These changes will require the reallocation of 150 public car parking spaces located behind the KGV Building to the Multi-Storey Staff Car Park and the Staff and Visitor Car Park on Hospital Road.

From 5:00pm, Friday 1 July 2022, the KGV Car Park will be closed to the public. The public will be redirected to the Multi-Storey Car Park and the Staff and Visitor Car Park on Hospital Road for alternative parking locations. This arrangement is anticipated to continue through to February 2023.

The works include the new Parent and Baby Unit (opened in May), a new Infusion Centre and administration buildings, new covered walkways, pedestrian crossings, green spaces and outdoor seating areas, new access to King George V Building, mobility access parking scheme spaces, and cultural and history displays. Arrangements are being finalised for a shuttle bus service to operate every 30 minutes between the car park and the main entrance of the hospital Monday-Friday between 830am and 5pm.

Whilst we are confident that these changes will cause minimal disruption for staff, we are cognisant that these changes are occurring during the most significant transformation in the 140 year history of RPA Hospital.
