The HSU Medical Physicists Industrial Advisory Committee has been working tirelessly in the new year to improve professional and industrial outcomes across the workforce.

The Industrial Committee's focus is the Award progression committee (clause 3). Progression under the Award is ad hoc and increasingly depends on where the employee is employed, impacting career progression for hard-working members. The Committee has done incredible work collating member feedback through state-wide meetings, surveys and other channels to identify the key issues and ambiguities in the Award progression committee.

With these issues clearly articulated, the Industrial Committee is reviewing each one to develop a proposed solution which should enable better career progression. The Committee will take these proposed solutions to a state-wide meeting shortly, where we will provide an in-depth update and seek endorsement on each proposal.

In other work, the Committee continues to collate and examine feedback on other key Award reform issues and monitor the impact of recent ACPSEM policy changes for the workforce.
