Your Medical Physicist Committee did not meet during October due to resources constraints in the HSU relating to the need to complete a substantial amount of evidence relating to the variation to the Hospital Scientist Award.

Work will recommence in earnest through the Committee on Award and industrial issues to improve your conditions at work in November.

In the meantime, your Committee has continued to collate Award issues, including but not limited to the Profession Committee. The intention is these issues will be tabled with the wider membership as soon as possible.

Your Union has been successful in supporting a member impacted by a misunderstanding of the recent changes to ACPSEM's registration policy. The affected member was retrospectively misclassified as a 'non-accredited' physicist. If you or someone you know faces similar issues, please contact us immediately.

We intend to hold a state-wide members meeting soon relating to the Registrar backpay issue. Keep an eye out for newsletter updates confirming a date for this meeting.

The Committee continues to seek representation from a wider group of members, including Registrars, MPS and DIMPs.
