Provide information and consultation on the SLHD Coding Unit and proposed changes to be enacted within this function within the District.




Background and Current Structure

- Since the decentralisation of coding to the facilities (2019), education and auditing frameworks have moved away from recommendations made by the SLHD Health Information Manager.
- Recent coding reviews have highlighted some basic standard audits/interaction with clinicians and validation checks have not been maintained at both Canterbury and Concord Hospital.
- The SLHD Health Information Manager currently manages the RPA/IRO/Balmain Coding Unit since March 2021.
- The Canterbury and Concord Coding Units are currently being managed by facility managers who subject expertise on coding is limited.



SLHD Coding Units - Current Organisational Chart





- Reporting line changes for the Canterbury and Concord Coding managers
- No impact to Canterbury and Concord Coding staff on daily tasks
- No reporting lines changes for Canterbury and Concord Coding staff
- Canterbury Coders to report to the Clinical Coding Coordinator
- Concord Coders to report to the Clinical Coding Coordinator
- No impact on RPA/Balmain Coding Zone



Outcomes expected as part of proposed changes

- Ensures consistency in management of coding services across SLHD
- Provide subject matter expert support to the Clinical Coding Managers from the SLHD Health Information Manager
- Consolidates resources and ensures support availability from across SLHD
- Auditing framework is standardised across SLHD
- Consolidation of education sessions to ensure consistency across SLHD
