Coffs Harbour Health Campus – Service and Workforce Enhancements

I am pleased to advise that the Coffs Harbour Health Campus has been allocated funding which will enable the offering of expanded services throughout the facility including within its new Clinical Services Building. It is anticipated that the enhanced services will be operational by April 2022 and will include:

- Sixteen (16) additional medical beds
- Two (2) additional Renal Chairs
- Additional specialised medical services
- Access to weekend Allied Health Services
- A Satellite imaging CT Scanner

In order to implement these services, significant workforce enhancements will be allocated across the facility and include:

- Nursing: 25.52 FTE
- Medical Workforce: 6.8 FTE
- Patient Support Services: 14.08 FTE
- Allied Health (inclusive of Radiology): 6.75 FTE

Consultation has commenced with meetings held or scheduled between management and staff within these services.
