
Below for your information is a summary of the key changes to positions within your membership. Please be advised that the below changes do not result in any significant impact or loss of position for your members.

1	Regrade of Physiotherapist Level 1/2 to Level 3, Respiratory Close Observation Unit, 0.58 FTE
2	Regrade of Physiotherapist Level 1/2 to Level 3, Neurosciences, 0.42 FTE
3	Regrade of Dietitian Level 1/2 to Level 3, Neurosciences, 0.2 FTE

As you can imagine, with the opening of the new Acute Services Building and the new configuration of the wards, there will also be some physical relocation of staff members to new wards within the hospital. These changes will be communicated to staff members.
