## **Update on Relocation and integration of the Medical Day Unit into the Division of Cancer and Ambulatory Support**

On 11 August 2020 we circulated a consultation paper with proposed changes to the Medical Day Unit (MDU). These changes proposed to permanently integrate and relocate the service into the Division of Cancer and Ambulatory Support (CAS). The proposed changes largely concern staff from CAS and the Division of Medicine in addition to patients who use this service and the services of Haematology and Chemotherapy Day Units located on Level 4 of the Canberra Region Cancer Centre (CRCC).

Feedback from this consultation process was addressed through a face to face meeting and subsequent consultation paper provided on 23 September 2020. This consultation paper included a summary of feedback and outcome. The second consultation process focused on the transition period with predominantly verbal and limited written feedback received.

Implementation of the transition has commenced as per the phased approach detailed in the consultation paper provided. Staff will be provided further information as affected.

We will continue to work with all affected staff to ensure that they are supported and that any concerns are addressed.
