

HSU Win at Mater Private Hospital re Food Services Carts

In conjunction with your HSU sub branch representatives Trish Gilmore & Noel Atutahi and your HSU Organiser Peter Mason, members in food services raised concerns in relation to the size and weight of carts, and questioned why the carts needed to be pulled and not pushed.

As of May 31, we are pleased to notify members that management have now undertaken a comprehensive investigation into the old food carts and as a result have launched a trial of a new slimline and lighter cart, thus hopefully eliminating the significant safety concerns.

Management also informed the sub branch that a majority of food services staff have been part of the trial and have provided feedback.
