Re: Notification of move – HealthShare Corporate ICT to eHealth NSW

I am writing to advise the Health Services Union that HealthShare NSW plans to transfer the ICT functions of HealthShare Corporate to eHealth NSW effective from 23 July 2018.

This move is consistent with the HealthShare ICT Strategy to transfer responsibility for ICT service lines to eHealth. The transition provides staff with a number of benefits including greater opportunities for career progression and skills enhancement.

I have attached a current organisational structure and proposed structure post the move. There will be no change to position descriptions or employment conditions for moving staff, and their locations remain the same.

It is anticipated that over a period of six months the teams will be given broader exposure and opportunities to work on a range of different projects within the Service Delivery directorate of eHealth NSW.

We will be offering one on one meetings with moving employees to discuss any issues and questions that might arise.

A staff meeting to discuss the proposal has been scheduled for 12 June 2018 at 9am at Gladesville Hospital, Building 23.

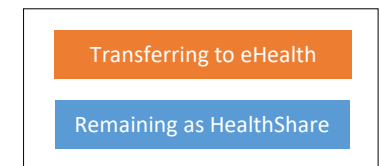
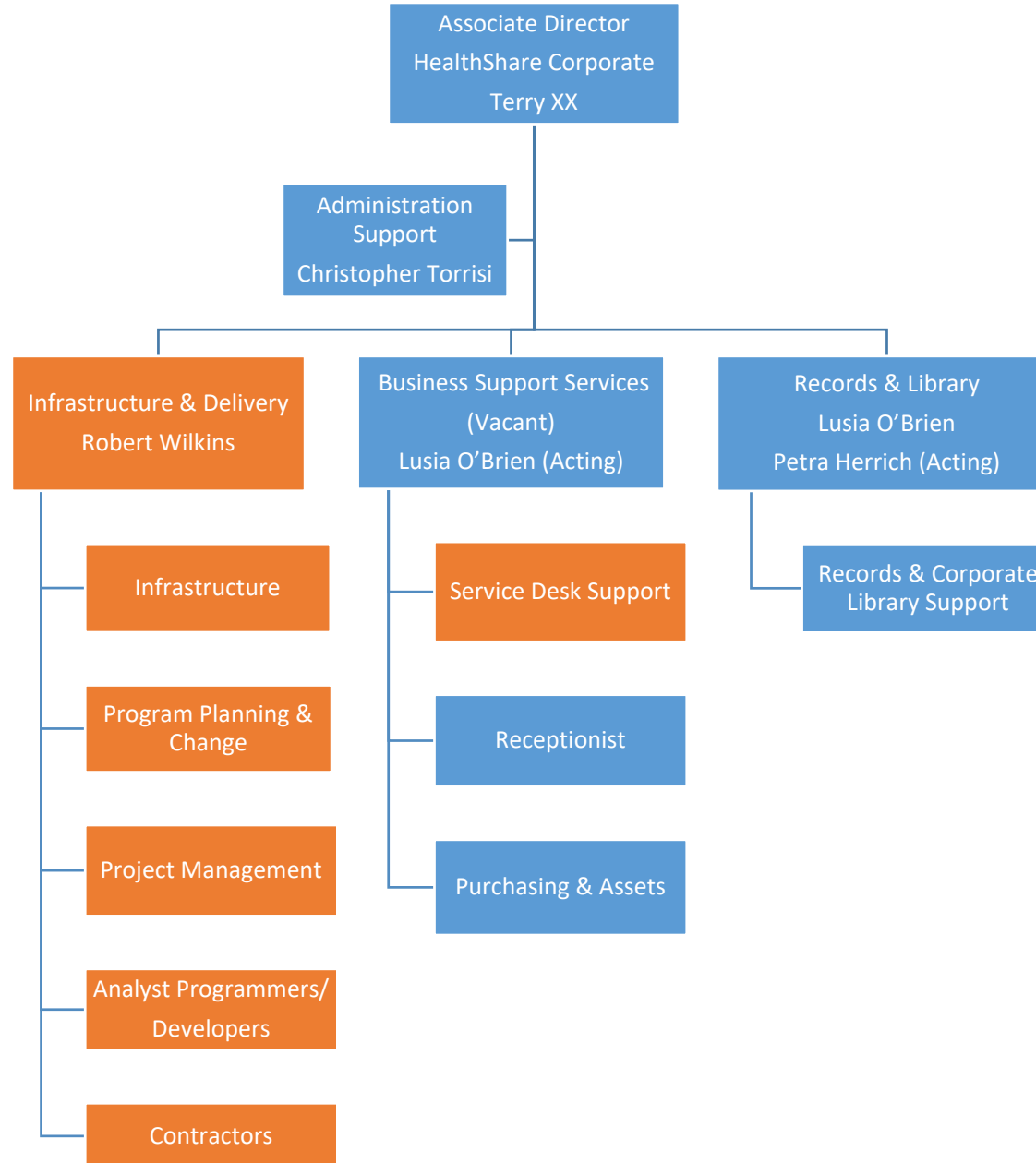
