Re: Transition to HealthRoster

Dear Mr Hayes

I write in relation to Justice Health & Forensic Mental Health Network (the Network) transitioning from ProAct to HealthRoster, which is the new rostering system for all NSW Health entities.

As the Network is one of the last NSW Health entities to transition to HealthRoster you may already be aware of its implementation; that said HealthRoster is the new on-line rostering system that has been purposely designed for NSW Health and is being rolled out across the NSW Health agencies, districts and speciality networks.

In relation to the implementation of HealthRoster for the Network the key transition activities and dates, prior to our go-live in October 2018 and first pay date using the new system of 18 October are:

- Staff training – three weeks commencing 13 August
- Roster builds and creations - September
- Finalisation and roster confirmation – October
- Go live Pay Period – 1 – 14 October
