Following on from discussions held at the Union Specific Consultative Committee (USCC) for the Stage 2 Redevelopment of Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital, I am writing to clarify changes to the car parking arrangements for staff at Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital (HKH).

Over the past several months due to decommissioning of buildings and early Stage 2 Redevelopment building works there have been changes to available staff parking on site at HKH.

As of Monday, 2 July 2018 the car park (Gate 7) on Derby Rd has been closed to allow for the construction of the Clinical Services Building. In order to ensure there is sufficient parking for staff, Health Infrastructure entered into an agreement with Westfield on behalf of HKH to access 160 spaces that are free-of-charge for staff and a shuttle bus service. This arrangement is paid for by project funding.

An Expression of Interest process was conducted for full-time and part-time staff wishing to apply for a parking card. There was more than 180 staff who applied for a parking card and staff were randomly allotted a card. Those who were not successful were placed on the waiting list.

The shuttle bus service is available to all staff, not just those accessing the car park at Westfield and has been well utilised and well evaluated by staff. There have been no complaints of staff lateness or significant waiting times for the bus and utilisation increases weekly.

The multi-storey car park is expected to be completed in November this year, with usage from January 2019. There will be more than 700 car spaces available on-site to staff and visitors.

The multi-storey car park will subject to car parking fees as per PD2013_031 *Hospital Car Parking Fees Policy: Campuses which are subject to car parking development*. It is expected that communication regarding this change will commence in the next two weeks for staff and patients/consumers. We are happy to provide you with a copy of the communication when available and will discuss the impact of this change with members of the USCC at the next scheduled meeting.
