

Tweed Heads Hospital Domestic Services Roster

On Wednesday 25 July, the HSU was presented with a new proposed roster for Domestic Services.

The proposed roster was stopped when it became apparent to the HSU that there had been no briefing by management to all Domestic Services staff, and therefore no input on attempting to mitigate any adverse effects the proposed roster may have.

On Tuesday 31 July, at a meeting of Domestic Services HSU members, they called on management to urgently hold a staff briefing on the roster proposal.

The HSU has advised management that we seek the staff briefing to be held on Thursday 9 August. Your organiser Peter Kelly will be present at that meeting.

Once HSU members have been briefed on the proposed roster, your HSU Organiser Peter Kelly will hold a meeting with members to discuss any issues with the proposed roster.

These issues will then be taken back to management to start the proposal of consultation with the HSU and management.

The HSU will keep you informed of progress on this matter and any roster proposal will be put to a meeting of HSU members in Domestic Services to vote on.
