NSWA bungles PICU offers in South West Sydney

ADHSU delegates met with the Service about concerns over the handling of the latest PICU recruitment process. NSWA had bungled the number of formal 'offers' to work as PICU compared to the number of actual positions available. They initially attempted to rescind the offers, even though the contracts were formed.

We said we would not accept a reduction in the number of PICU positions offered over the 24-month contract despite the Service trying to rip up the contracts.

Although the Service appear to have agreed to honour the six positions at this stage, ADHSU is not calling a victory just yet. We still have many outstanding issues relating to rosters, work instructions and the overall management of PICU that need to be addressed before our members can feel safe.

ADHSU will seek a further meeting with the Service to work through all these issues to give our membership the confidence that they will be fully supported to allow them to look after the needs of the community they serve.
