

Urgent advice: Radiography members, Manly & Mona Vale Hospitals

Dear Member,

The following is urgent information to members at Manly or Mona Vale Hospitals, employed as Radiographer, who are transferring to Northern Beaches Hospital.

It has come to the attention of the HSU that the letter of offers/contracts issued to transferring employees by Healthcare Imaging Services have incorrect information.

The incorrect details include: incorrect classification; shift hours based on 38 hour week rather than 35; and incorrect notice requirement for employees wishing to resign.

The HSU raised this issue last week with management, and were advised that new contracts will be issued. This has not yet occurred.

Members **should not** sign the letters of offer.

We are seeking that new letters be issued, and a further 10 days for offers to be accepted.
