Registration and Professional Indemnity Insurance

AHPRA and the Paramedicine Board of Australia have opened the registration portal for paramedics and you can now apply to become a registered paramedic.

While we understand the mixed feelings from members regarding registration, it is here, and to practice as a registered paramedic they must comply with the requirements set out by AHPRA and the Paramedicine Board.

The requirement to hold Professional Indemnity Insurance (PII) has been an area of concern for many Paramedics. ADHSU recently met with the Chair of the Paramedicine Board, Stephen Gough, and here is what you need to be aware of:

- Paramedics **MUST** be covered by PII to practice as a Paramedic
- ADHSU provide \$20MIL PII to ALL members at no extra cost
- The PII provided by ADHSU covers you outside of your main workplace including secondary employment where you earn up to 100K
- In some cases, the EMPLOYER will cover PII, but **WILL NOT** cover you **OUTSIDE** of that workplace (e.g. secondary employment or volunteering at your child's sporting event)
- HSU already covers registered health professionals in allied health and is able to assist with any enquiries
- Financial members will be receiving a certificate of currency for PII shortly via email

If you join ADHSU today, for only \$11.10 per week (tax deductible), you will be covered by the HSU professional indemnity insurance, as well as membership to a transparent, democratic and membership led union.
