

Negotiations continue for your new RFBI enterprise agreement

Dear Member,

Over the last few months, we've been continuing negotiations for your new RFBI enterprise agreement.

The HSU has been campaigning hard for the priorities that union members set earlier in the year, in your log of claims.

While the negotiations have been going well, we are yet to receive a formal wage offer from management.

HSU members work hard in roles all across RFBI, so it is vital that you have a fair wage offer that delivers a decent pay increase.

Until we receive that offer, one of the biggest pieces of this puzzle will be missing.

We are now at the final drafting stage of the negotiations, so it's time for RFBI to put their cards on the table and let us know what their full offer is.

The HSU has also been saying that your wage offer must be back paid to 1 July 2018, to ensure that you don't miss out on increases that you should have received.

We have another drafting meeting scheduled next week on Wednesday 24 October. We will continue to push hard for your log of claims, particularly for a fair wage increase and to improve your rights at work.

We hope to be in a position to give a full report back to HSU members on what's been agreed, or not agreed, following our next meeting.

Remember, this is your agreement and we get the best result when everyone is strong and united. If your colleagues are not yet HSU members, ask them to join today.
