

Lismore Base Hospital Security Resolution

Dear Member,

Yesterday the HSU and NSWNMA met with LBH and LHD management regarding increasing security to appropriate levels.

Management at the meeting advised that they would not address staffing levels until both the internal security review and the Ministry of Health security review are completed – by February at the earliest.

It is simply outrageous that your employer should try to evade their responsibility to provide a safe workplace for a further 3 months.

The HSU Sub Branch at LBH will not let this happen.

Management has been informed of a joint motion and bans put in place, as below:

Members of the HSU and NSWNMA at Lismore Base Hospital have today resolved to impose bans on the processing of payments for Medicare and private health insurance claims by the Northern NSW Local Health District.

We implore you again to address and increase security to the numbers both unions have asked for.

Let's stick together and get the safe workplace we all deserve.
