

HealthShare PTOs: Bans still on

Dear Member,

We've heard that there are some members of HealthShare's management team who are going around telling union members that the bans against multi loading patients if one might be left alone have been lifted.

This is not true.

We are currently waiting on a response to our demands from the Health Secretary and we have made clear that the bans remain in place until then.

As a reminder, the current bans are: **No patient is to be unloaded unless there is an emergency, or they are at their final destination;** and **HSU PTOs will not load a second patient in the vehicle if there is a chance they may be left alone at any point of the transport.**

Keep up the good work. It's up to PTOs to protect their patients from an employer who cares more about efficiency than patient safety.
