

SVPH & Mater Pay Offer on the table

Dear Member,

Yesterday, the HSU bargaining team met again with management to continue the negotiation for your new enterprise agreement and have pushed for the claims developed from your feedback.

Management have put forward a pay offer of 2.5% per year of the agreement and have ruled out any new allowances for training, laundry and infectious work.

Management have also refused to put paid domestic violence leave into the agreement along with the WHS policy and have now sought to limit the scope of the dispute settlement procedure.

You also asked for a wholesale review of classification structures which management is refusing to do.
