Following on from your HSU organiser's recent visit to your worksite, the Union would like to remind our members about reasonable workloads and staffing.

It is totally unfair and unsafe if you present yourself at the start of your shift and your employer expects you to do sixteen hours' worth of work in your rostered eight hours due to staff shortages. If you are dealing with extremely high workloads, you cannot perform your highly valued duties either to the standard that your employer would expect, or to the standard that patients deserve.
