However, it's deeply disappointing to hear that other concerns can't be addressed, supposedly due to budget constraints. It is a basic right that all members go to work in a safe and comfortable working environment. Having no air conditioning in the building in the extreme temperatures currently being experienced is simply unacceptable.

Therefore, we will now be seeking a commitment from management to address these concerns at the upcoming Mental Health Combined Staff Consultative Meeting this Friday. The Union will keep members up to date following the meeting.

The HSU will continue to fight for a safe workplace that our members expect and deserve.
