

Central Coast Car Parking Survey – Results

Further to [Newsletter 76](#), the HSU has now surveyed members employed by Central Coast Local Health District regarding the introduction of car parking fees for staff at Gosford Hospital.

The results are in and over 82% of members said they believe CCLHD's treatment of Gosford Hospital staff is unacceptable towards, while over 66% have said they are willing to campaign for a better offer.

Members have now spoken and sent a clear message to the employer that they must come back to the table to negotiate a better deal that is fair for everyone.

Those people who indicated they want to be active in this campaign will be contacted directly by your Organiser Brendan Roberts over the next week.

The next stage is to now speak with all of your colleagues and get them involved. One way to start that conversation is by asking them to sign a petition demanding they come back to the table. Your delegates will be out and about over the next few weeks with the petition.
