Following ongoing concerns for the safety and wellbeing of HSU members in Security, and another incident where a Security Officer was allegedly assaulted at the John Hunter Hospital, the Greater Newcastle Security Officer Sub Branch has notified the HNELHD that **effective from 1800 (6pm) Friday 29th March, all security responses and duties will be undertaken by no fewer than two (2) security officers.**

The safety and wellbeing of everyone working at John Hunter and accessing the hospital is paramount, and members have taken this strong stance to highlight these concerns. The HSU offers support and congratulations to the Security Officer Sub Branch for taking this approach and protecting all members' right to safety at work.
