

## Forensic Medicine Coroner's Court Complex Safety Concerns

Dear Member,

The HSU notified Michael Symonds, Executive Director FASS on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2019 of the many industrial and work health and safety issues identified by members at the Forensic Medicine Coroner's Court Complex. It is apparent that poor and inconsistent staff consultation has occurred, and proactive management systems are lacking and have not dealt with issues previously raised by staff.

The HSU called for a Union-Specific Consultative Committee (USCC) to be convened by FASS to discuss and resolve the issues. Members have attended HSU meetings and sent submissions to HSU. In addition, many members have expressed interest in attending the USCC meeting as delegates, representing their colleagues. This meeting is scheduled for Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2:00pm-3:30pm, at FMCCC.
