

More signs our campaign for fairer parking is working

Dear Member,

Just after 5pm yesterday, Central Coast Local Health District issued a memo to all staff stating that until 19th April, staff working afternoon shift and entering and exiting between 1pm and 11pm will have access to the current \$2.30 casual parking fee in P2. Management continue to explore other casual parking options for staff.

We congratulate Central Coast LHD for making the right decision. However more questions have arisen, including:

1. Why only afternoon staff? Why not all staff on all shifts? Morning shift staff also used the free and safe service at Showground Rd.
2. Why only for one week, rather than indefinitely?
3. Why is Central Coast Local Health District treating its employees differently based on what shift they are rostered onto?
4. Does this mean staff rostered on morning shift and parking by taking a ticket have to pay the current full fee of \$19.90?
5. What about those staff who start at 11am who will obviously enter the carpark prior to 11am?
6. Are staff who did not use the service excluded? If so, how will this be monitored?
7. What other options are CCLHD exploring for casual parking?

We have written to the Chief Executive seeking answers to these questions asking for a reply at his earlier convenience.

Meanwhile, we are busy getting ready for next Monday morning's **Breakfast BBQ at 6 Racecourse from 5:30am**. Every member is welcome to attend and send a clear message that we want a free and safe alternative option, instead of being forced to pay exorbitant rates for parking at the Hospital. We will stand up for free parking.

Let's make Monday the biggest gathering of Union members ever seen at Gosford Hospital!
