Dear Member,

Unfortunately, and despite repeated efforts by your HSU representatives, Catholic Healthcare have failed to re-start the negotiations for your enterprise bargaining agreement (EBA).

The process has dragged on for too long and demonstrates that Catholic Healthcare management do not prioritise the interests of staff.

We will therefore now need to commence exploring our options for industrial action.

HSU representatives will be attending Catholic Healthcare worksites in the coming weeks to discuss with members their preferred options for industrial action (see the attached survey).

As members will see from the survey, industrial action covers a very broad range of activities, from wearing stickers to lunch time walk outs, etc.

It is important to note that an industrial activity will not go ahead unless a large percentage of members are willing to participate in it.

It is unfortunate that Catholic Healthcare management have taken such a negative approach to these negotiations. Nearly every other Aged Care company in NSW has been able to negotiate a fair and reasonable EBA.

That is why industrial action, and the associated media attention, is the only path forward to ensure you get the fair pay deal you deserve.
