## NSW Ambulance are still causing undue fatigue on Illawarra inspectors

Dear Member,

The deadline for NSW Ambulance to officially sign off on the roster proposed by our Illawarra DOM members passed on Thursday the 18<sup>th</sup> April. NSW Ambulance didn't even contact any of the affected members in relation to a decision as promised. ADHSU spoke to NSW Ambulance last Thursday evening and were informed that a decision might be made this week.

ADHSU members understand that this is occurring during a holiday period which makes the approval process difficult. The roster, however, was put to NSW Ambulance on the 4<sup>th</sup> of March and therefore the Executive group have had ample time to review the proposal and approve it.

On Thursday night, Illawarra/Shoalhaven DOM's voted to reimplement industrial action. **Duty Operations Managers in the Illawarra/Shoalhaven will no longer deal with hospital delays in any capacity. This commenced from COB Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> April.**

These work bans will continue until the roster trial is officially approved by NSW Ambulance and a date is set for implementation.
