A modest win for some of our newest members

Some good news for some of the newest paramedics joining the Service.

Paramedics who were part of 'in-service 2' classes 1901, 1902, and 1903 are going to the sector they were promised.

There had been an issue where paramedics had been appointed to a sector were coming out of in-service 2 and being sent to totally different parts of Sydney. For those named classes this has been fixed.

The Service maintains that in the future they will not be honouring this practice. We're not going to accept that. We're going to fight in solidarity with new starters now and into the future. We're going to demand a fair go for the paramedics of today and tomorrow.

The distinction the service is making between the generations is around some of the correspondence that had been sent to these classes. The ADHSU will be telling the Service that they need to give their new employees as much certainty about where they will be working permanently as early as possible.
