While management initially claimed they were unaware of members' concerns, after some discussion your HSU representatives were able to come to the following agreement with management:

1. Executive management have agreed to arrange a full Environmental Services Department meeting without departmental managers or supervisors present. This meeting will be attended by both your Sub Branch Executive and HSU Organiser. This will allow our members to raise concerns directly with the RPAH Executive.

Details of the meeting are still being finalised but it was agreed this meeting should take place within the next week. You will be notified as soon as the date and time is confirmed.

This is the first step towards resolving members' concerns and demonstrates that by sticking together we can make real change at your workplace.
