Statements must be submitted to the Returning Officer as a <u>word document (.doc)</u> either by email to nswelections@aec.gov.au or on a cd. The statement and photo must be lodged with the nomination form and reach my office or postal address no later than 12:00pm noon (AEST) on 5 July 2019. Note: that emails greater than 6 MB size may not be accepted by the AEC's firewall.
