Results of vote: bans are lifted from 1900 tonight

See this afternoon's [newsletter](#) on the offer of settlement made by the Ministry in the IRC today.

The results of the vote on lifting the bans are 398 (88%) for lifting the bans, and 55 (12%) voted to keep the bans on.

That means bans are lifted from 1900 tonight. Again, we commend ADHSU membership for standing firm including by defying orders. It has sent a clear message to the Ministry that you are willing to fight to protect the conditions that were handed down to our generation from those before us.

The Rural Incentive scheme is protected by the award for another year, and the Ministry know that if they try to remove it next year (or while the award is opened up in the major industrial case), they know we'll fight again, and fight hard.
