

## It's a NO vote at Bolton Clarke

Dear Member,

Last week Bolton Clarke management reported that a majority of staff voted NO to the proposed enterprise agreement. This means that the agreement has not been accepted and your union will continue to push for a better and fairer agreement for all staff.

The HSU immediately wrote to management to ask exactly how many people voted for and against the agreement. We suspect that it was a lot, but management have refused to give us the numbers so far.

Unions have written to Bolton Clarke management requesting that bargaining recommence, so that we can keep fighting for a good enterprise agreement and a fair wage outcome.

On Monday there will be a conference with the Fair Work Commission. We hope to have more information about the next steps following that meeting. We will keep HSU members up to date as things progress.
