Re: Realignment of the Health Education and Training Institute, District HETI

The Health Education and Training Institute writes to advise that consultation with staff is underway for a realignment of the District HETI unit within the Professional Practice, Interprofessional Collaboration Portfolio. The District HETI unit develops on-line education modules for NSW Health.

The realignment of District HETI is a minor restructure where a minor number of positions within the unit are affected. The change has been contained to the one area within HETI and affects one permanent and eight temporary employees.

The restructure will enable realignment of resources within the District HETI Model to fit within the model and manage surges of demand for courses.

The realignment will be managed in accordance with the NSW Health Policy (PD2013_042 Restructuring Policy and Procedures).
