## Inspectors stand up to new unreliable work instruction

Late on Friday night, NSW Ambulance put out three new work instructions that our members say drastically reduce autonomy for Inspectors. This would have lasting effects, not only for Inspectors, but for our paramedic members as well. They would not be as affective in managing incidents, and staff welfare issues.

Yesterday afternoon, ADHSU inspector members held a teleconference in relation to these work instructions. 46 Inspectors from across the state (representation from every sector) dialled in and voiced their concerns. They agreed that if these work instructions were not consulted on properly, they would have no choice but to take industrial action today (Saturday).

NSW Ambulance have agreed to retract these work instructions and meet with inspectors to hear their concerns. Congratulations to AHDSU members for again standing strong.
