Re: Extra Public Holiday NSW Health Employees 2019/20 and 2020/21

This is to confirm the proposed dates of the extra public holiday provided for in NSW Health Awards, for both the 2019/20 and 2020/21 Christmas/New Year breaks.

As noted in our last correspondence on this, while past practice has been to consult over the upcoming date each year, the proposed dates for both this year's and the following year's extra public holiday have been identified, to provide more certainty to NSW Health staff.

NSW Health Agencies have determined:

- for the 2019/20 Christmas/New Year break the proposed date is Tuesday 31 December 2019;
- for the 2020/21 Christmas/New Year break the proposed date is Thursday 31 December 2020.

Note that the dates do not include employees employed by the Ambulance Service of NSW, the NSW Ministry of Health or covered by the Barrier Industrial Council Agreement, which will make other arrangements.
