Every month there are 40 people assaulted in NSW Hospitals. In many cases, these are dedicated health workers, just like yourself.

Why does this keep happening?

Since our statewide strike on 1 August we have seen several major incidents which have resulted in far too many health workers suffering serious injuries.

Every health worker deserves to have a workplace which is safe and free from the potential of physical and verbal violence.

Our team of Organisers will be onsite at **Royal North Shore Hospital** on **Wednesday 4 September** to talk to health workers about our Campaign.

We are asking all our members to show their support and get involved in our campaign "A Safe Hospital is a Healthy Hospital" and demand the NSW Government take action to stop the ever-increasing levels of violence in NSW Hospitals.
