

Wyong Hospital Redevelopment Update

Dear Member,

As you know, the redevelopment of Wyong Hospital is beginning to take shape. While it is expected that the new building will be completed at some point in 2021, consultation has already started with our Union alongside the other health unions.

Attached to this newsletter are the minutes from the most recent meeting and the timeline of when discussions regarding specific areas will take place.

As a result of our experiences when consulting with Central Coast Local Health District about the recently completed Gosford Hospital redevelopment and expansion, the HSU has advocated that HealthShare and Pathology North are represented at these meetings. This will help to ensure our members working in these areas have an avenue for their concerns to be raised, so that genuine consultation can take place prior to CCLHD making decisions which may impact members.

On another note, as part of the redevelopment of Wyong Hospital, CCLHD are planning to introduce paid parking for staff and visitors. The HSU has already publicly stated we are opposed to these fees being introduced, with a strong campaign in full swing that has already engaged the Central Coast community.

This ongoing campaign has so far resulted in over 10,000 people signing a petition to the NSW Government against the fees. The matter is now set to be debated on the floor of NSW Parliament at 4pm on the 19th September.

During the consultation period, which will be ongoing right up to opening of the new Hospital, the HSU will continue to update and provide feedback to our members through newsletters and site meetings. However, it is very important that members take interest and become active in this process by encouraging your colleagues to join and become part of their Union.

5.1	ICU	<p>CCLHD main points of discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">It was explained that the new ICU department is to move to the new building, it will be situated near theatres and emergency department. Moving from an 8 bed unit to a 9 bed unit with an additional 3 shell spaces.It was explained that the user group has endorsed the schematic design. The design has adequate interview room space, meeting room space, SIM room, staff facilities along with consumer feedback.It was noted that the project will pay for the extra new equipment required – work has commenced with Capital Works.The CCLHD confirmed that workforce planning will commence once final design has been endorsed. It is anticipated that planning will have plans complete within 12 to 18 months.The CCLHD confirmed that we are currently in tender process by August is should have been confirmed. Building will ideally commence in

5.2	Wyong Paediatric Unit	<p>CCLHD main points of discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It was explained that the new build will encompass a new 23 hour short stay unit moving towards a 48 hour stay unit, 14 beds are planned with an opening number of 10 beds. The area will also have family and office space. • It was confirmed that Security have reviewed the plans and have agreed with the design and placement of the security cameras. • It was noted there will be a link with ED. • The user group confirmed that there will no longer be an outdoor area. <p>HSU main points of discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will there be consideration of a policy on an aggressive child? 	
5.3	Inpatient Units / AMU	<p>CCLHD main points of discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It was confirmed that there is a need for more medical beds within the new build. The final cohort has not as yet been decided. There will be 28 bed in each unit. Each unit will have a staff room and office space. Single bed rooms will be around 50% along with 50% double bed rooms. • The double bed rooms will be toe to toe and each bed will have a window view. • It was noted there will be greater availability for storage, less walking. There will be a decentralized way of working which is similar to what is currently occurring within the hospital. • It was noted and KR will confirm if the Medical Services Panel will have both air and oxygen when this information is available. • KR confirmed there will be adequate office space. 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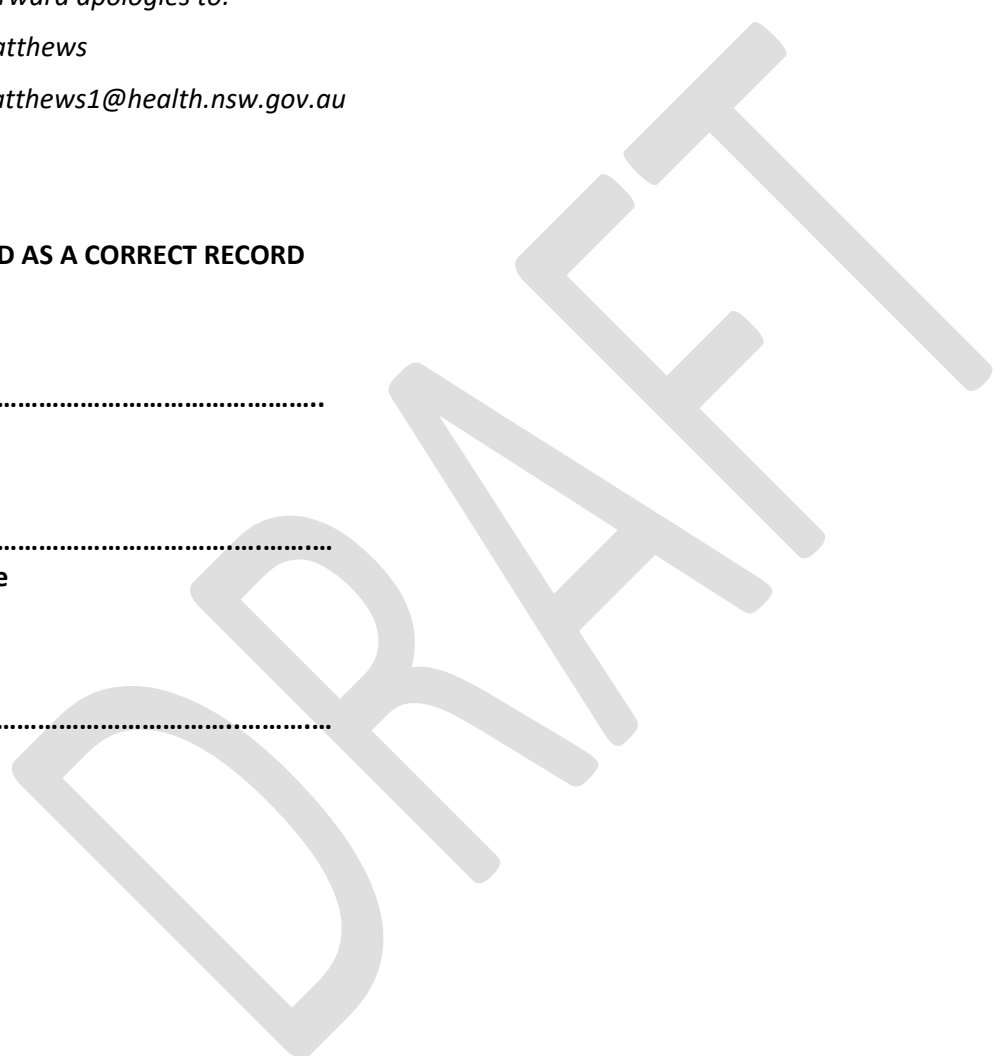
