RE: Mater Hospital - Proposed Restructure

We are writing to inform you that the Mater Hospital, as part of St Vincent's Health Australia (SVHA) is considering a restructure following a review of its services.

Monday 9th September 2019, we will begin informing all staff who are affected by these changes that they are invited to a meeting to begin the consultation process. We estimate that this process will be completed within a month.

We have identified approximately 3 staff employed under the St Vincent's Health Australia Support Services Agreement 2018, whose roles may be affected by the proposed changes. These include changes such as reporting structures, responsibilities, and in some cases, we do expect redundancies. The Hospital is committed to make every attempt to redeploy staff in the first instance.

We will continue to provide support to all our affected employees, which will include exploring redeployment opportunities at other facilities, EAP and the services of pastoral care where appropriate.
