Over 90% of members who responded to the recent survey rejected the offer and last night the HSU Lavery Sub Branch formally endorsed the position.

It has to be acknowledged that there have been improvements in this latest offer- a result of the hard work and grit of members collecting over 300 signatures in the petition calling for fair wages- but members have clearly said that the offer still isn't good enough.

Now it's up to Lavery management- will they come back to the table with a better offer?
