We finally have a decision being handed down in the Crib Break Case.

The HSU will review it and give members an update on what is decided as soon as possible tomorrow.

While we don't know what the decision will be, we will be pushing for the Ministry to process any pay increases and back pay as a matter of urgency. Unless there is an appeal, it means members should receive their 2.5% per year increase (a little over 7.5% increase with back pay within a month from now).
