The HSU has received the attached draft structure for Community Health.

It is disappointing that the LHD has once again failed to provide the information that the HSU asked for back on 16 July 2019. Below is that was sent at that time:

The HSU writes to you concerning the NNSWLHD proposed Community Health Review, VAN Services and Community Nursing Review.

To provide feedback, the HSU requires that NNSWLHD provide the following:

- *The existing organisation chart and proposed organisational chart showing each employee's position in both charts;*
- *New position descriptions*
- *More information on the Allied Health Specific Professional Support Co-ordinator role (i.e. location, reporting line, grading etc).*

To date, the HSU has received a large volume of member feedback, however this focuses on the lack of information listed above.

Can you please provide this ASAP to enable to HSU and its members to give full feedback on the proposal.

Further, the HSU is unable to facilitate a USCC prior to 12 August 2019, so can you please arrange for the meeting to take place after this date.

Please confirm the above actions will take place in writing by COB today.

The HSU will be writing to the LHD to remind them of their obligation to provide the information that was asked for on 16 July 2019 and their obligation to consult in good faith.

In the meantime, please continue to have conversations with your colleagues about this review. If they are not yet a member of the HSU, ask them to join their Union at www.hsu.asn/join.

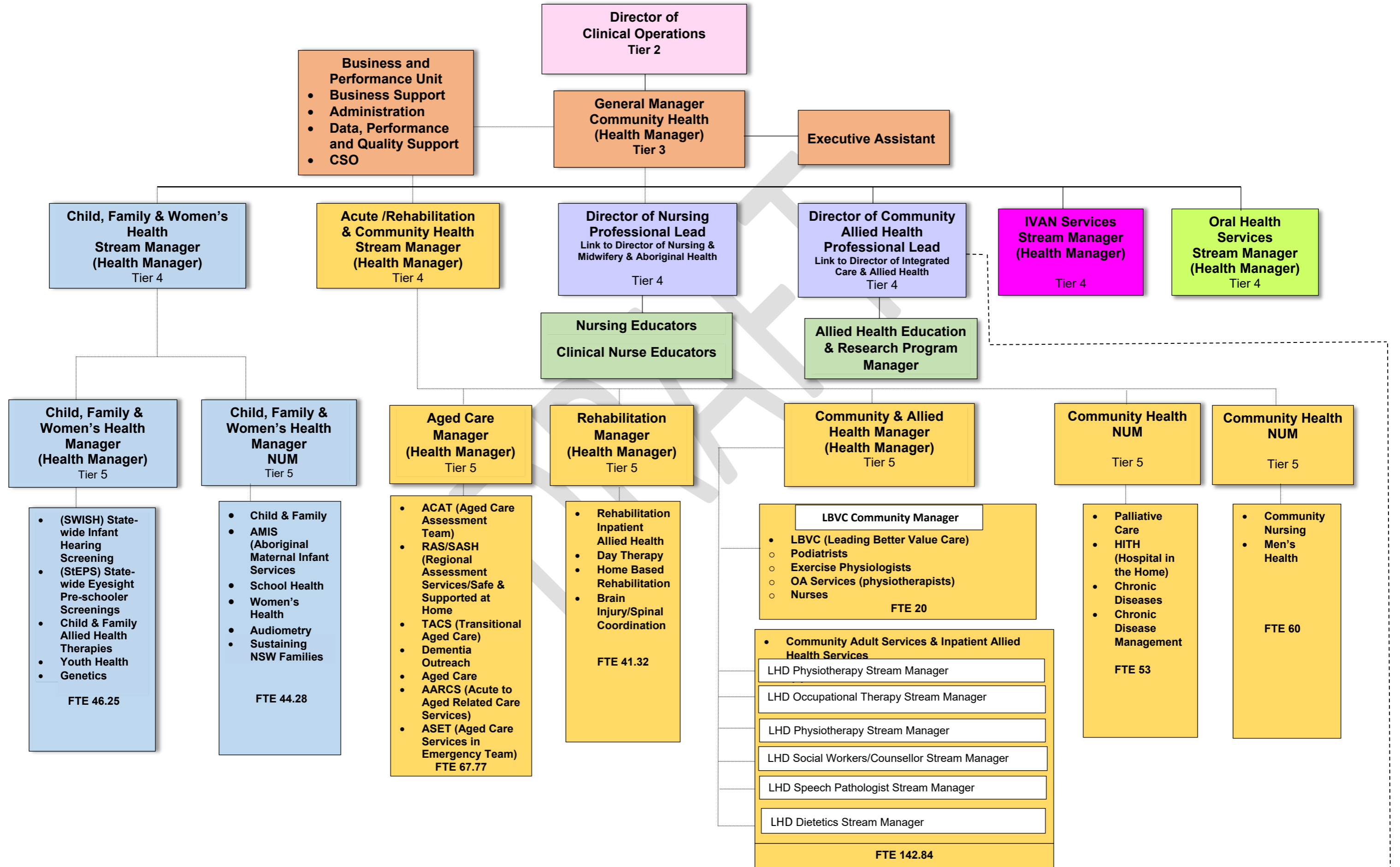
