

Parking Fees set for debate in NSW Parliament tomorrow

For much of this year many HSU members, other health workers and Central Coast community members have been campaigning against the recently increased parking fees at Gosford Hospital and the proposed introduction of these same fees at Wyong Hospital once redevelopment has been completed.

Following a mammoth effort in collecting 10,000 signatures on our petition, the issue will be debated in the lower house of NSW Parliament at 4pm tomorrow, Thursday 19th September.
