

Sydney Adventist Hospital Renovations Update

Dear Member,

We recently received correspondence from your employer regarding its intention to replace a portion of cladding above Level 5 of Clarke tower. This decision has been made as one of the three substances used in the cladding has been found to be non-compliant by the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment.

The Hospital has advised that there will be no interruption to service as it replaces the cladding. Further to this, the hospital has undertaken a number of safety precautions to mitigate the risks posed by the cladding.

The Hospital will hold meetings with staff in order to communicate this process.

The HSU will be closely monitoring the situation, as well as communicating any safety concerns raised by members to management.
