Today the Health Services Union received a response from ISS management about bargaining an agreement for cleaners at St George Hospital.

Shamefully, ISS management have stated that they are content to continue paying you significantly less than what is being paid for other cleaners in NSW Health – or even ISS cleaners in other hospitals – and don't wish to commence bargaining.

Now we organise.

Under legislation you and your co-workers have the right to bargain with ISS management- they don't get to decide. We just need to show the Fair Work Commission that the majority of ISS cleaners at St George Hospital want to bargain.

Over the next week HSU organisers and local HSU delegates will be coming around with a petition for you to sign which calls on ISS management to bargain.

Make sure to let your co-workers know that they should sign the petition and join the HSU – there has never been a more important time to stand united.
