

Healthe Care Bargaining Update: Workloads, Classifications and the Money

Dear Member,

Yesterday your HSU Bargaining Team met with Healthe Care management to progress negotiations of your new Agreement.

The team did an incredible job in advocating on behalf of members – if you work with one of them, be sure to give them a huge pat on the back today.

There was extensive discussion about our classification claims in Administration, CSSD, and Clinical Coders, where we are calling for increased increments to reflect the increased responsibilities of the roles.

We talked about workload stress and the need for management to understand the rights and entitlements of members – that members have to fight for what they are clearly entitled to.

But there was very limited discussion about the money.

HSU members are calling for a 5% pay increase and equal pay across all Healthe Care sites. Healthe Care is yet to put a counter offer to this.

Next steps

Healthe Care has requested the HSU provide a detailed breakdown of each claim. Management will then consider these and we will meet again in November.
